



## Friday to Saturday Overnight Waiver & Policies for Missionaries

Any Missionary who will be serving an additional week and would like to stay after closing on Friday until Missionary arrival on Saturday will need to get approval through our Missionary Coordinator, Caleb Brandt. ### **Friday-Saturday Camp Notices:**

- No Directors will be available on Camp Barnabas property from Friday (Closing Day) at 2:00 pm through Saturday (Missionary Arrival Day) at 3:00 pm.
- The Dining Hall will be closed from Friday at 2:00 pm through Saturday at 3:00 pm. There will be limited food options available during this time. Missionaries are not able to use any appliances (excluding the microwave) in the Camp Barnabas kitchen. Missionaries are permitted to use the “Staff” portion of the refrigerator and the microwave. Missionaries will be responsible for acquiring their own food and cleaning up after their meals during this period of time. Camp Barnabas will leave some basic food in an easily accessible spot for Missionaries, to access. Any Missionaries with a special diet will need to communicate with the Kitchen Staff before Friday at 2 PM to ensure that they have available food options.
- The Camp Office will be closed.
- No office phones will be available for use (Missionaries will need to retrieve their cell phones).
- All male Missionaries will be in a male-designated sleeping area with no access to activities (Pool, Ropes Course, PaintBall Area, Canoeing/Kayaking, Female Cabins, Well House). Females are not permitted in this area at any time.
- All female Missionaries will be in a female-designated sleeping area with no access to activities (Pool, Ropes Course, PaintBall Area, Canoeing/Kayaking, Male Cabins, Well House). Males are not permitted in this area at any time.
- Laundry services at Camp Barnabas are extremely limited. These machines are used on a first-come, first-serve basis. These machines must be shared by all Missionaries and Staff staying at Camp Barnabas. Please be respectful and follow all posted guides, including promptly moving your clean/dry laundry. Laundry must be removed from the machines before 1 PM on Saturday. There is no laundry service available during the week.

### **General Rules:**

- No alcoholic beverages, firearms, fireworks, or personal pets are allowed at any time.
- Smoking is not allowed on the grounds of Camp Barnabas.
- All vehicles are to be parked in designated parking areas only. No parking or driving off paved or gravel services.
- All litter and trash must be kept in proper receptacles.
- The front gate is locked after 10:00 p.m. unless other arrangements have been made.
- All persons must have on shoes at all times except in the pool.
- Camp Barnabas recommends that all persons walking after dark use a flashlight.

- Campfires are not permitted.
- Please help to conserve energy by turning off all lights and fans when not in use.
- Food and drinks are not allowed in the cabins or sleeping quarters at any time. They attract unwanted insects, rodents, and other pests.
- Camp Barnabas Staff may enter a facility at any time to inspect the premises, to observe activities, and provide maintenance of the premises as well as any other reasonable purpose.
- No equipment (including beds, mattresses, chairs, tables, etc.) may be moved from any building at any time.
- No kitchen or dining hall equipment may be removed for any reason at any time. This includes plates, cups, flatware, and cooking utensils.
- Please immediately report any lost or broken equipment to a Senior Camp Staff member.
- In the event of fire or storm damage, machinery that ceases to function, or power outage, contact the Facilities Director immediately.
- Unchaperoned activities, including walks off of trails into pastures or woods, are strictly prohibited due to dangers that are present in nature.
- No one is allowed to step below the Cross at Inspiration Point.

Staying on property is a privilege. Failure to comply with these rules will result in immediate expulsion from camp.

#### **Medical & Liability Waiver**

I further understand and assume all risks associated with participating at Camp Barnabas.
