1. FILL OUT AN APPLICATION

4. COMPLETE CIRCUITREE EMPLOYMENT FORMS

Please fill out all required forms at the link <u>HERE</u>. This is where you include information for your required background check, input time-off requests, input your medical information, and your CPR certification. **This must be completed by April 29.**

- → We require that all Staff members possess a current CPR certification that is valid throughout your staff session. We highly encourage you to receive a CPR certification through the <u>Red Cross</u> or the <u>American Heart Association</u>.
- Time off requests must be submitted and approved 60 days in advance of your start date.
- Flight transportation will need to be provided so we can arrange transportation if needed.

5. COMPLETE ONLINE TRAINING

We want to ensure our Staff are equipped to fulfill their responsibilities and be trained to handle any situation. We do this by starting training before you get to camp. You'll receive an email with a link to Online Training in the spring. This must be completed by April 29.
